### Before Use

: Insert batteries in Sound Experience

When changing batteries or doing maintenance, please set ON/OFF to OFF on the top unit.

Remove the NEOREST remote control

When the remote control is taken off, don't place it on the NEOREST lid. Otherwise, it will scratch the lid or fall when the lid opens automatically

Hold the battery cover and pull it towards you

Insert 4 AA batteries

ullet Use the ullet ullet symbols to install the Caution: batteries correctly \*When changing the batteries, use new ones and use the same brand.

 When the batteries are almost dead, the volume can only be set to a maximum of "3". Replace the batteries when this happens.

When the batteries are replaced, the equalizer settings will return to default.



Push ▶ to stop playing music

- If | Is pushed and then no buttons on the Sound Experience are pushed for the next 2 minutes, the display light will turn off.
- If is not pushed, the Sound Experience will stop playing after 20 minutes. However, continuous play can be set from 1-60 minutes (using 1 minute intervals). For details, please see "Changing the automatic stop timer" section
- If the Sound Experience stops playing during a song, it will start from the beginning of that song when play resumes.

- 1) TOTO warrants its NEOREST 550 ("Product") to be free from defects in materials and workmanship during normal use when properly installed and serviced, for a period of three (3) years from date of purchase. This limited warranty is extended only to the ORIGINAL PURCHASER of the Product and is not transferable to any third party, including but not limited to any subsequent purchaser or owner of the Product. This warranty applies only to TOTO Product purchased and installed in United States, Canada and Mexico.
- 2) TOTO's obligations under this warranty are limited to repair, replacement or other appropriate adjustment, at TOTO's option, of the Product or parts found to be defective in normal use, provided that such Product was properly installed, used and serviced in accordance with instructions. TOTO reserves the right to make such inspections as may be necessary in order to determine the cause of the defect. TOTO will not charge for labor or parts in connection with warranty repairs or replacements. TOTO is not responsible for the cost of removal, return and/or reinstallation of the Product.
- 3) This warranty does not apply to the following items:
